

Minimum General Requirements

The minimum general requirements for the 4-year BBS program are as follows:

- An academic year will consist of a minimum of 150 teaching days excluding the days taken for admission and annual examinations.
- The total instructional hours in an academic year will be 615 (150 days x 4:10 hours a day). For courses requiring field and practical work, additional hours of study will be required.
- There will be a minimum of five periods (i.e. class hours) each teaching day.

Graduation Requirements

The BBS program extends over four academic years and the BBS degree is awarded on its successful completion. All candidates for the BBS Degree must fulfill the following requirements:

- → The successful completion of 2000 marks as prescribed with passing grades in all the courses (subjects)
- The passing scores obtained in all theory and practical components of each course separately. Completion of courses for the fulfillment of the BBS program within the time limit prescribed by Tribhuvan University.
