

Examination System

The AS and A Level final examinations are held twice a year i.e. May/June and October/November, the results of which are published in August and January respectively.

Grading System

Students are required to take minimum five subjects in order to qualify for the degree. Students can also take additional subjects depending upon their interests and abilities. Students are assessed on a letter grade scale where A* is for the highest level of achievement, E is for minimum required performance and U stands for ungraded.

Course Combination

The College offers a wide range of subjects and various subject combinations to fulfill the requirements and to prepare students for university studies such as Science, Medicine, Engineering, Business and Liberal Arts.

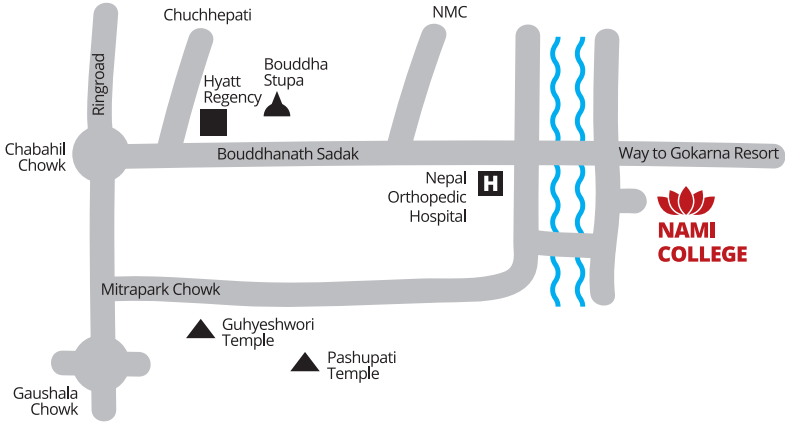
Transportation Facilities

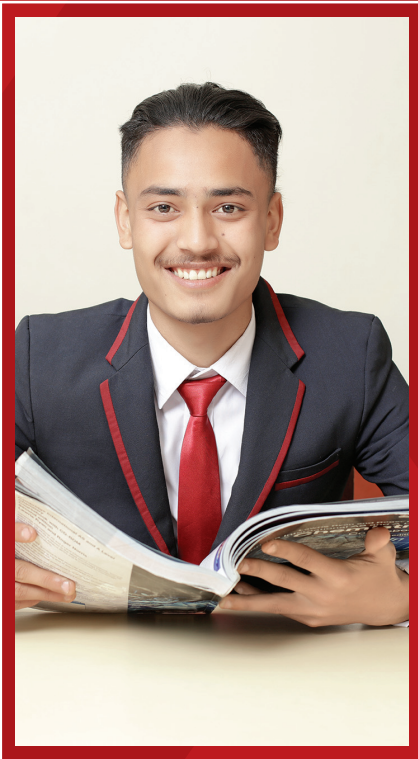
